

The Kemmerer City Council met in regular session this 22nd day of April, 2024, at 7 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, Kemmerer, Wyoming. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present on roll call were Mayor William Thek, Councilmember Marlin Batista, Councilmember Robert Bowen, Councilmember Dale Hicks, Councilmember Bill Price, Councilmember Mark Quinn, and Councilmember Jamie Thornock.

Motion was made by Councilmember Hicks to approve the agenda as amended; seconded by Councilmember Thornock and unanimously approved by council.

Mayor Thek read a proclamation proclaiming April as Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention Month.

NEW BUSINESS:

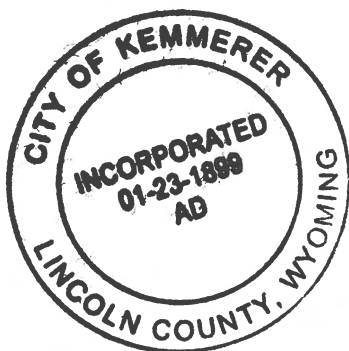
