Motion was made by Councilmember Hick to approve the agenda as presented; seconded by Councilmember Quinn and unanimously approved by council present.

Councilmember Bowen joined the meeting via teleconference; 6:13 p.m.

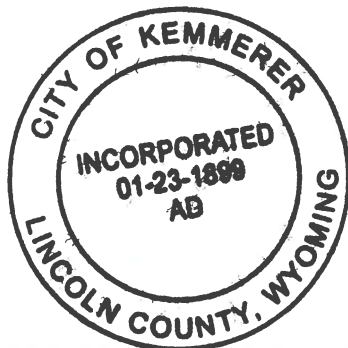
Discussion on the health, dental, vision, and life insurance providers and options were discussed.


