Present on roll call were Mayor William Thek, Councilmember Marlin Batista, Councilmember Jim Burnett, Councilmember Dale Hicks, Councilmember Mark Quinn (via Google Meets), and Councilmember Bill Price.

Discussion regarding the impact funding from the Industrial Siting Application for the construction and operation of Terra Power's Kemmerer Power Station Unit 1 (Project) began.

Councilmember Price recused himself from the special meeting; 6:06 p.m.

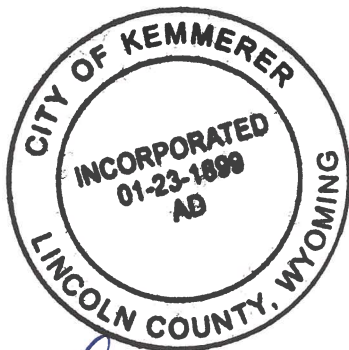
Councilmember Price rejoined the special meeting; 6:07 p.m.

BUSINESS ITEM:

Motion was made by Councilmember Burnett to authorize the mayor, staff, including city attorney, to request and negotiate with Lincoln County and other parties for impact funding regarding the Industrial Siting Application submitted by US SFR, LLC for the construction and operation of Terra Power's Kemmerer Power Station Unit 1 project; seconded by Councilmember Price. The mayor then called for the question. Those voting "Yea," were Councilmember Batista, Councilmember Burnett, Councilmember Price and Councilmember Quinn. Councilmember Bowen abstained from the vote. Motion carried.

There being no further business before the Council, Councilmember Burnett made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Councilmember Batista and unanimously approved by council present, 6:16 p.m.
