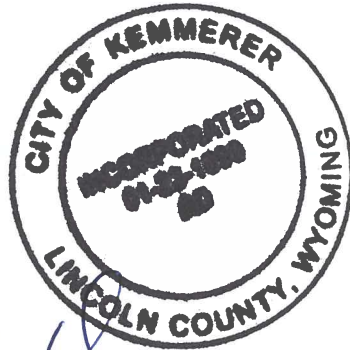
TABLED BUSINESS ITEM:
